

ORDINANCE C-01-11

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$422,297.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE PHASE 2 STRINGTOWN ROAD CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City has applied for a grant and received a final recommendation for funding from the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement Program for the reconstruction and limited widening of Stringtown Road from McDowell Road to Hoover Road; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is estimated to be \$7,100,000 and the recommended award from OPWC is \$6,396,893, which is comprised of \$3,902,104 in a grant and \$2,494,789 in a loan; and

WHEREAS, this improvement will include reconstruction of the pavement, curb, gutter and sidewalks, widening of the roadway, installation of a new street lighting system, traffic signal improvements and private utility coordination; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need to improve the public utilities (storm, water and sanitary) in conjunction with the proposed roadway improvements; and

WHEREAS, these improvements will support and encourage economic investment into the commercial space on the west side of the I-71 interchange, and

WHEREAS, these improvements will benefit the citizens of Grove City by easing traffic congestion, beautifying the area with street lighting and new sidewalks, and improving ADA access to the area; and

WHEREAS this funding will support the development of construction plans, engineering, legal services, permitting, and bidding of the said improvements; and

WHEREAS, engineering and related services are necessary in order to complete work under the Ohio Public Works Commission Grant Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$422,297.00 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund to be transferred to the Capital Improvement Fund and into account 305-3093-8600-780 for the Current Expense of Detailed Engineering, Permitting, Bidding and Construction Plan Services for the Phase 2 Stringtown Road Corridor Improvements.


SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.




