

ORDINANCE C-11-97

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 501 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF GROVE CITY, OHIO, TITLED GENERAL PROVISIONS & PENALTY & DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Environmental Court requires a method of appeal for certain Code violations; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to incorporate a new section to the Codified Ordinances of Grove City, Ohio to provide an appeal process to satisfy said Court; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the health, safety, and general welfare of the community due to the Court refusing to hear any of these types of cases until the Appeal Provision is in place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby enacted a new Section 501.13 which shall read:

501.13 RIGHT TO APPEAL - CERTAIN GENERAL OFFENCE ORDERS


- (a) Whenever a person has been cited with certain Code violations that require notice to be given to the offender prior to enforcement of said violation(s) (i.e. 505.01, 521.11, 521.18, 523.02, 523.03, 523.04, 543.02, 543.03), then the notice shall include the offenders right to file an appeal to the alleged violation(s).
- (b) The petition to appeal must be in writing and must be filed no later than five (5) days after notice, referenced in (a) above, has been served upon the alleged offender. Said petition to appeal must be filed with the Office of the Director of Public Safety within said five (5) day period.
- (c) The Director of Public Safety, or his designee, shall conduct a hearing on the appeal. The procedure to be followed, including notice of hearing, and appeal rights from said hearing, shall be the same as specified in Ohio Revised Code Section 119.07 through 119.12, inclusive.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for reasons stated in the preamble and shall therefore go into immediate effect.
