

ORDINANCE NO. C-18-90

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$8,810.92 FOR CURRENT
EXPENSES TO REIMBURSE THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON

WHEREAS, the City of Grove City and the Township of Jackson entered into an agreement for communication services; and

WHEREAS, contained within the said agreement, an estimate of costs of operation for the year January 1, 1989 through December 31, 1989 was included; and

WHEREAS, after an accounting of the this past year of service it has been determined that the Township had an overpayment of \$8,688.11 plus a balance due them of \$122.81 from the 1987 payment; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the agreement the overpayment will be reimbursed to the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$8,810.92 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund.


SECTION 2. Said monies shall be placed in Account 439-7 and a warrant in the amount of \$8,810.92 will be paid the Township of Jackson from said account.




