

ORDINANCE C-02-03

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE C-40-77 TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY AND ALLOW FOR BENEFITS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, Section 3.04 of the Charter of the City of Grove City, Ohio provides that the Mayor shall receive an annual salary of \$2,400 per annum and also provides that the Council may, by ordinance, change this salary but no increase may become effective until the beginning of the next term of office after its adoption; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance C-40-77 did increase the annual salary of the Mayor to \$6,000.00 per annum; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance C-4-83 amended Ord. C-40-77 and increased the annual salary of the Mayor on a graduated scale, ending at \$12,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the salary for the position of Mayor and finds it necessary and proper to increase the salary to compensate the Mayor for the responsibility of carrying out the duties of that office; and

WHEREAS, certain employment benefits may become available to the Mayor and Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of Grove City, Ohio shall receive an annual salary of \$20,000.00 effective January 1, 2004 and thereafter if not amended by Council. Said annual salary shall be divided into twenty-six (26) equal amounts and paid to the Mayor in bi-weekly installments along with the regular payroll of all city employees.


SECTION 2. The Mayor and Council shall be eligible for certain employment benefits as may become available.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




