

# ORDINANCE C-58-01

## AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$40,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF E911 EQUIPMENT UPGRADES

WHEREAS, the Franklin County 911 Planning Committee has mandated the implementation of upgrades of our current 911 equipment to receive the transfer of digital data for wireless 911 calls; and

WHEREAS, this requirement was not anticipated in the preparation of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for FY2001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$40,000.00 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund for the Current Expense of E911 equipment upgrades.

SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.




