

ORDINANCE NO. C-90-90

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 935 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF GROVE CITY TO CREATE SECTION 935.14
WHICH ADOPTS CHAPTER 1145 OF THE COLUMBUS CITY CODE
TO ALLOW THE ENFORCEMENT OF COLUMBUS SEWER USAGE
ORDINANCES WITHIN THE CITY OF GROVE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus has directed the City of Grove City and other municipalities using the Columbus Sewer system and tributaries to the system to incorporate into their Codified Ordinances by reference Chapter 1145 of the Columbus Codified Ordinances to allow the enforcement of sewer use regulation as directed by the Federal and Ohio Environmental Protection Agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. There is hereby enacted Section 935.14 of the Streets, Utilities and Public Services Code of the Grove City Codified Ordinances which shall read:

935.14 APPLICATION, ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF COLUMBUS SEWER USAGE ORDINANCES.


So long as the City discharges its sewage, industrial waste, water and other liquid waste into the transportation, pumping and treatment system of the City of Columbus, all of the provisions of Chapter 1145 of the Columbus City Code, both as they exist and as they are hereafter amended, relating to the regulation of sewage use are hereby adopted by reference and made applicable to the City sewerage system. In the event of conflict between the provisions of this chapter and Chapter 1145 of the Columbus City Code, the provisions of Chapter 1145 of the Columbus City Code shall prevail. Officers and employees of the City of Columbus are hereby empowered to enforce such provisions of the Columbus City Code within the boundaries of the City.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.






