An Ordinance to Authorize the Director of Public Service to Enter into A Contract for Construction and Improvement of Sewage Treatment Plant and To Declare an Emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. C-86-60 passed the 5th of December, 1960 authorized the Director of Public Service to advertise for and open bids for the construction and improvement of the Sewage Treatment Plant, and

WHEREAS, an acceptable bid for the construction and improvement of the said Sewage Treatment Plant was received on the 5th of January, 1961, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the said bid is the lowest and best bid and should be accepted in order to get the work underway at the earliest possible moment, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation in the Department of Public Service in that the construction and improvement of Sewage Treatment Plant is needed at the earliest possible time to expedite the finishing of the sewage treatment facilities to the City of Grove City, Ohio thereby preserving and protecting the public health and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the improvement and construction of the Sewage Treatment Plant and to pay the costs of advertising, printing, inspection and contingencies incident thereto.

SECTION 2. That for the reasons stated above and made a part hereof, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
