DATE OF ENACTMENT _____

An ~~emergency~~ ordinance enacted by the City/~~Village~~ of Grove City, Franklin County, Ohio, in the matter of the hereinafter described improvement, under the supervision of the Director of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation is considering improving a portion of the public highway which is described as follows:

To improve the capacity of the intersections and to meet the requirements of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices by installing various New Traffic Signals and appurtenances, replacing various existing Traffic signals and appurtenances, performing minor geometric and channelizing modifications.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the City/~~Village~~ of Grove City, Ohio:

SECTION I (Consent)

That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said City/~~Village~~ be and such consent is hereby given to the Director of Transportation to construct the above described improvement, in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Director.

SECTION II (Cooperation)

That said City/~~Village~~ hereby proposes to cooperate with the State of Ohio, in the cost of the above described improvement as follows:

By assuming and contributing the entire cost and expense of said improvement inclusive of Construction and Construction Engineering, less the amount of Federal-Aid Funds set aside for financing the improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration: and

The City further agrees to assume one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of Preliminary Engineering and Right-of-Way costs.

SECTION III (Authority to Sign)

That the City Administrator of said City/~~Village~~, is hereby empowered and directed on behalf of the City/~~Village~~ to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the planning and construction of this

SECTION V (Maintenance and Parking)

That upon completion of said improvement, said City/~~XXXXXX~~, will thereafter keep said highway open to traffic at all times, and

- (a) Maintain the improvement in accordance with the provisions of the statutes relating thereto and make ample financial and other provisions for such maintenance; and
- (b) Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions in a manner satisfactory to the State of Ohio and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes and permit no signs, posters, billboards, roadside stands or other private installations within the right-of-way limits; and
- (c) Place and maintain all traffic control devices conforming to the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices on the improvement in compliance with the provisions of Section 4511.11 and related sections of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (d) Regulate parking in the following manner:

PROHIBIT PARKING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE IMPROVEMENT.

SECTION VI (Right-of-Way, Utility Rearrangement and Saving the State of Ohio Harmless of Damages)

- (a) That all existing street and public way right-of-way within the City/~~XXXXXX~~ which is necessary for the aforesaid improvement, shall be made available therefor.
- (b) That the ~~XXXXXX~~/Municipality will acquire any additional right-of-way required for the construction of the aforesaid improvement.
- (c) That arrangements have been or will be made with and agreements obtained from all public utility companies whose lines or structures will be affected by the said improvement and said companies have agreed to make any and all necessary plant removals or rearrangements in such a manner as to be clear of any construction called for by the plans of said improvement and said companies have agreed to make such necessary rearrangements immediately after notification by said City/~~XXXXXX~~ or the Department of Transportation.
- (d) That it is hereby agreed that the City/~~XXXXXX~~ shall at its own expense, make all rearrangements of water mains, service lines, fire hydrants, valve boxes, sanitary sewers or other municipally owned utilities and/or any appurtenances thereto, which do not comply with the provisions of Directive 28-A, whether inside or outside the corporate limits as may be necessary to conform to the said improvement and said rearrangements shall be done at such time as requested by the Department of Transportation Engineer.
- (e) That the construction, reconstruction, and/or rearrangement of both publicly and privately owned utilities, referred to in subsections (c) and (d) above, shall be done in such a manner as not to interfere unduly with the operation of the contractor constructing the improvement and all backfilling of trenches made necessary by such utility rearrangements shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications and shall be subject to approval by
