ORDINANCE NO. 1559

7-6-59

TO REQUIRE PRIVATE SWIMMING POOLS IN THE
CITY OF GROVE CITY TO BE FENCED IN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. A private swimming pool means one used only by the owner of the pool and friends as an additional accessory to a private residence.

Section 2. No person shall locate, construct or install any swimming pool or wading pool or make any change in such pools or appurtenances thereof without surrounding said pool with a fence at least six feet in height and containing openings in said fence no larger than four square inches in area and subject to the approval of the Building Inspector.

Section 3. No swimming pool or wading pool shall be located in any front yard of any lot or between any street and required building line. A swimming pool may be located in part of the rear yard behind a residence as an additional authorized accessory use.

Section 4. No swimming pool and no wading pool shall be located, constructed, or used unless and until the plans thereof shall have been approved, and the construction of same shall have been approved, by the Building Inspector, as to structural safety and an application shall be made and a building permit issued therefor in the same manner and a fee charged at the same rate as provided for other construction.

Section 5. Whoever violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$500.00.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from
and after the earliest period allowed by law.
