

ORDINANCE NO. C-18-85

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT THE GROVE CITY AREA ARTS COUNCIL GANTZ FARM HOUSE RESTORATION COMMITTEE TO HOLD A WINE FESTIVAL AT THE GANTZ ROAD PARK ON MAY 4, 1985 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Grove City Area Arts Council wishes to hold a wine festival at the Gantz Park on May 4, 1985 for the purpose of raising money for the restoration of the Gantz Farm House; and

WHEREAS, Section 903.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City states: "No drugs or alcoholic beverages shall be permitted on park property"; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city that this section of the Codified Ordinances be waived prior to May 4;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Permission is hereby granted to the Grove City Area Arts Council to hold a wine festival at the Gantz Road Park on May 4, 1985.


SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 903.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances that no alcoholic beverages be permitted on park property is hereby waived for this one occasion of a wine festival on May 4, 1985 at the Gantz Road Park.

SECTION 3. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared an emergency and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.


