ORDINANCE C-10-61

An Ordinance to Vacate an Unnamed Alley and to Declare an Emergency

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio by Curtis Kunz, and

WHEREAS, such petitioner is the owner of land adjacent to an unnamed alley and requests that such alley be vacated, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause for such vacation of such alley and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and it should be vacated, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that such vacation be immediately accomplished, and

WHEREAS, all written consent to such vacation has been filed by all property owners abutting such unnamed alley with City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. That the unnamed alley running parallel to Park Street and generally parallel to Grove City Pike, and situate between Park Street and Grove City Pike be and the same hereby is vacated from the dead end of said unnamed alley adjacent to a plot of land owned by Grove City Farmer's Exchange Company, to a line crossing said alley, perpendicular to said alley, said line being an extension of the eastern boundary of lot 9, Joseph Buckholtz's Addition to the Village of Grove City, Ohio in a southerly direction to north of the easterly corner of Lot 3, Joseph Buckholtz's Addition to the Village of Grove City, Ohio, it being the intention herein to vacate

SECTION 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
