ORDINANCE NO. 22-59

ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A ONE FOOT STRIP OF LAND ON GLENNA AVENUE FOR CITY PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section I. That the deed from Elvin White and Virginia White, husband and wife, of a one-foot strip of land, hereinafter described, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted, and that the dedication for public use for said area is hereby accepted and confirmed, said area being described as follows: Situated in the County of Franklin, in the State of Ohio and in the City of Grove City:

All of the one foot reserve extending across the northerly end of Glenna Avenue as said reserve is shown on the recorded plat of Charles White's Addition to Grove City, Ohio as said Additions is shown on the recorded plat of record in Plat Book 22, page 92, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, said reserve being Parcel 1198 on the Auditor's Duplicate. This Deed is given on condition that the City of Grove City accept said grant and dedicate said land to public use for street purposes.

Section II. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.
