ORDINANCE NO. C-24-60

To provide for bonds for City Officers

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the administrative operation of the City of Grove City with respect to providing for bonds for all officers, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide immediately for the giving of such bonds now, therefore,

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City that,

Section 1. The Bond for the Finance Director shall be in the amount of \$25,000.00.

Section 2. The bonds of all officers and all employees of the City of Grove City shall be in an amount of \$25000000 and shall be blanket position bonds conditioned upon faithful performance of duties.

Section 3. All bonds shall be approved by the Mayor of the City of Grove City, and shall be filed with the Clerk of Council. (C-24-60)

Section 4. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto, and made a part hereof, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


