

# ORDINANCE C-26-92

## AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$4,500 FROM THE LOCAL FIVE DOLLAR LICENSE FUND FOR CURRENT EXPENSES

WHEREAS, a portable traffic counter devise has been identified that will provide for a safe and efficient means to survey traffic volume, speed and weight; and

WHEREAS, this information is important for the design and implementation of traffic safety plans and overall development of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$4,500 from the unappropriated monies of the Local Five Dollar License Fund for the purchase of said portable traffic counter devise.

SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.






