

ORDINANCE C-28-64

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE CRUISERS AND RADAR EQUIPMENT FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE, DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY; TO APPROPRIATE \$5,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUND OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT NEW EQUIPMENT FUND, Account 2 C 11; TO RESCIND ORDINANCE C-15-64, and to Declare an Emergency.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual operation of the Division of Police, Department of Safety, in that it is immediately necessary to replace two existing police cruisers and Radar Equipment; and

WHEREAS, such replacement is immediately necessary in that it directly affects the safety and welfare of the Citizens of the City of Grove City and should be immediately accomplished.

NOW, THEREFOR, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. The Safety Director of the City of Grove City is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, receive and open bids and to enter into a contract for the purchase of two Police Cruisers.

SECTION 2. The Safety Director of the City of Grove City is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, receive and open bids and to enter into a contract for the purchase of Radar Equipment.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated fund of the general fund, the amount of \$5,000, to Account 2 C 11, Police Department New Equipment Fund.

SECTION 4. Ordinance C-15-64 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 5. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the treasury for payment from any of the following appropriations upon receiving proper certification and voucher therefore approved by the Board or Officers authorized by law to approve the same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure,

ORDINANCE C - 29 - 64

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5 (B 1), ENTITLED "Probation and Advance ment within the Compensation Schedule", of Ordinance C-50-63, entitled "An Ordinance for the Adoption and Administration of Position Classification, Compensation and Fringe Benefits Plan for the Municipal Service and to Rescind Ordinance No. C-89-60, and all amendments thereto, and to Declare an Emergency", and to Declare an Emergency.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Grove City provides that the Civil Service Commission shall conform to the rules of the Civil Service Statutes of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, a change in the State Statutes, regarding police, has been effected.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1. Ordinance C-50-63, Section 5 (B 1), entitled "Probation and Advancement within the Compensation Schedule," which reads:

After initial appointment or promotion to a merit position, the first four months of service in the position to which appointed or promoted shall be considered a period of probation. In the event that the employee does not satisfactorily complete his probationary period, he shall be separated from the service except that in the case of promotion from a lower position, he shall revert to such position.

is amended to read:

After initial appointment or promotion to a merit position, the first four months of service in the position to which appointed or promoted shall be considered a period of probation. The probationary period for employees of the Division of Police shall be one (1) year. In the event that the employee does not satisfactorily complete his probationary period, he shall be separated from the service except that in the case of promotion from a lower position, he shall revert to such position.

SECTION 2. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto which is made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
