

ORDINANCE NO. C-28-74

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR WHICH THE CITY OF GROVE CITY MUST PROVIDE DURING THE REMAINING MONTHS ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1974

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make Federal Revenue Sharing Appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Grove City during the remaining months ending December 31, 1974, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Grove City that these appropriations be made as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. From the monies in the fund known as the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund and from all monies estimated to come into said fund from any and all sources during the remaining months ending December 31, 1974, there hereby is appropriated to the use of the several departments, offices, and objects from which the appropriation must provide, the following sums for the use during the remaining months ending December 31, 1974



SECTION 2. From any sums which shall be expended from the above appropriations and which are a proper charge against any other department or against any person, firm or corporation shall, if repaid within the period covered by such appropriation, be credited to the fund from which such payment was made and be considered as reappropriated from such original purposes; provided that the net total of expenditures under any item of said appropriation shall not exceed the amount of said item.

SECTION 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to issue his warrant against the appropriate account for the amounts appropriated and for the purpose stated in this ordinance upon receiving the proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by an officer authorized by law to approve same or authorized by an ordinance or resolution of council to make expenditures.

SECTION 4. This ordinance provides for appropriations for current expenses and, according to the charter, shall go into immediate effect.


