
PROHIBITING PARKING HOUSE TRAILERS OR AUTO-HOMES IN ANY AREA OF GROVE CITY, OHIO

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Grove City, Ohio:

- SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 238, heretofore enacted which prohibited the parking of house trailers for any purpose whatsoever is hereby repealed.
- SECTION 2. House trailers and auto-homes parked in areas of the village, other than in licensed trailer camps approved by the Franklin County Board of Health, have become a menace to the health and welfare of the residents of this village.
- SECTION 3. Hereafter, it shall be unlawful to park any house trailer or auto-home in any outside area of the village for any use whatsoever, except that parking house trailers or auto-homes in any trailer camp approved by the Franklin County Board of Health, shall not be prohibited, and except house trailers may be parked for a period up to 10 days in any six month period for repairs only and not for living quarters, after issuance of a special permit by the Grove City Police Department.
- SECTION 4. Any person, either owner, holder or bailee who violates the provisions of this ordinance may be fined fifty (\$50.00) dollars for each such violation. Each separate day or part thereof, that a trailer or auto-home is parked in violation of this ordinance, shall be considered as a separate offense.
- SECTION 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the protection of the health and safety and welfare of the residents of Grove City, Ohio, and shall take effect immediately after its passage by the council of said Village.
