ORDINANCE NO. 28-58

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE TWO STORY
FRAME BUILDING APART FROM THE REAL ESTATE,
LOCATED AT 36 EAST PARK STREET IN THE
VILLAGE OF GROVE CITY, NOT NEEDED FOR
ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, AND TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following described personal property belonging to the Village of Grove City is not needed for any municipal purpose, to wit: one two-story frame building situated on Lot No. 37 of John Hoelcher Sub-division of the Village of Grove City, and known as No. 36 East Park Street and located on the North-east corner of the intersection of Park and First Streets in the Village of Grove City. Upon the sale of said building it shall be required that the building be removed from said location within thirty days from the date of the sale.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the Village of Grove City be and hereby is authorized to sell said personal property to the highest bidder according to law, upon the following terms: cash upon the giving of a Bill of Sale and the said Mayor and the Clerk of the Village of Grove City are hereby authorized to convey said personal property by a Bill of Sale to the highest bidder therefor according to law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Village of Grove City. The reason for such necessity lies in the fact that the land upon which the building is presently located is needed for other municipal purposes and such use is of immediate interest.
