

ORDINANCE NO. C-29-82

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUILDING CODE IN SECTIONS 1325.02, SWIMMING POOLS; 1331.04, PLUMBING; 1331.10, PLUMBING; AND 1341.05, HEATING, VENTILATING AND AIR CONDITIONING; 1351.02 ELECTRICITY TO AMEND OR SET FEES FOR PERMITS AND CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE

WHEREAS, there is a need to up-date certain permit fees and contractor's license fees in the Building Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 1325.02 of the Swimming Pools chapter of the Building Code of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to enact subparagraph (d) which shall read:

(d) The fee for either inground or above ground swimming polls shall be \$15.00.

SECTION 2. Section 1331.04 (c) of the Plumbing Code chapter of the Building Code of the Codified Ordinances stating permit fees and which reads:

- (c) Permit fees shall be the following:

The amount of any and all fees, as hereinbefore established, shall be doubled if any plumbing work has been commenced before an application for a permit for such work has been filed with the Building Inspector. However, this double fee shall not apply to any emergency or urgent necessity work if a permit for the work is obtained as provided for.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

- (c) Permit fees shall be the following:

The amount of any and all fees, as hereinbefore established, shall be doubled if any plumbing work has been commenced before an application for a permit for such work has been filed with the Building Inspector. However, this double fee shall not apply to any emergency or urgent necessity work if a permit for the work is obtained as provided for.

SECTION 3. Section 1331.10(a) of the Plumbing Code Chapter of the Building Code of the Codified Ordinances which reads:

(a) No person shall engage in or work at the trade or occupation of plumbing in the City as a master plumber unless the person is the holder of a license then in force issued by the City, giving him the right to perform or supervise such work, or unless the person has then in his employ a holder of such a license then in force supervising the work. The license shall be obtained by request therefor to the Building Department and request shall be accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and proof of holding a valid plumbing contractor's license issued by either the State of Ohio, any state certified city building department or Franklin County.

(b) Any person who performs any plumbing installation, or other plumbing work for hire, or without hire, for another person, shall be subject to the provisions of Section 1301.99 (Penalty).

SECTION 4. Section 1341.05 of the Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning Chapter of the Building Code of the Codified Ordinances which reads:

No person shall install, erect, alter, repair, reset or replace any warm-air, steam or hot-water heating plant, plants or parts thereof, or winter or summer air conditioning or ventilating systems within the corporate limits unless the person is the holder of a license then in force, issued by the City, giving the person the right to perform or supervise the work or unless the person has then in his employ a holder of a license then in force supervising the work. The license shall be obtained by application therefor to the Mayor or his designee, and proof of holding a valid heating ventilating and air conditioning contractor's license issued by either the State of Ohio or any State certified city building department.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

(a) No person shall install, erect, alter, repair, reset or replace any warm-air, steam, or hot-water heating plant, plants or parts thereof, or winter or summer air conditioning or ventilating systems within the corporate limits unless the person is the holder of a license then in force, issued by the City, giving the person the right to perform or supervise the work or unless the person has then in his employ a holder of a license then in force supervising the work. The license shall be obtained by request therefor to the Building Department and said request shall be accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and proof of holding a valid heating, ventilating, air conditioning contractor's license issued by either the State of Ohio, any state certified city building department, or Franklin County.

(b) Any person who performs any heating, ventilating, air conditioning installation or other heating, ventilating, air conditioning work for hire, or without hire, for another person, shall be subject to the provisions of Section 1301.99 (Penalty).

SECTION 5. Section 1351.02 of the Electricity Code of the Building Code of the Codified Ordinances which reads:

(a) Any person may make application for registration and the issuance of a license to do electrical contracting or installation work within the City by submitting a written application to the Mayor and proof of holding a valid electrical license issued by either the State of Ohio or any State certified city building department.

(b) Any person who performs any electrical contracting, electrical installation or other electrical work for hire, or without hire, for another person, shall be subject to the provisions of Section 1301.99. (Penalty)

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

(b) In order for a perspective Electrical Contractor to take the electrical test, he must make arrangements for a convenient time of testing with the Building Department. At the scheduled time of testing, the testee shall pay fifty dollars (\$50.00). Upon satisfactory passing of said test, the license shall be issued. If the test is not satisfactorily passed, the fifty dollars (\$50.00) fee shall be forfeited to the City and the test cannot be administered for six-months from date of previous failure.

(c) Any person who performs any electrical contracting, electrical installation or other electrical work for hire, or without hire, for another person, shall be subject to the provisions of Section 1301.99. (Penalty)


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


