

ORDINANCE NO. C-3-72

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT  
OF ONE POLICE DISPATCHER AND TO DECLARE  
AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance C-7-69 eliminated the position of Police  
Dispatcher; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to retain one police dispatcher; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the daily operation of the City  
which affects the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Grove City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. One Police dispatcher is to be retained and paid at  
the rate of \$1,680.00 annually from January 1, 1972 through December 31, 1972.


SECTION 2. For reasons stated in the preamble hereto, and made

effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval of the mayor.






