

ORDINANCE NO. C-3-87

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 351.17 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY ENTITLED "PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS"

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WHEREAS, the city has received numerous complaints from residents of various residential sections of the city concerning large commercial trucks parked in driveways; and

WHEREAS, these truck trailers and rigs detract from the residential character of neighborhoods by creating noise that disturbs the tranquility of neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, a safety hazard exists in residential areas due to hazardous fuels stored in the vehicles and fumes from the running motors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 351.17 of the Codified Ordinances which reads:

No commercial tractor, truck, trailer or commercial automobile weighing more than 8,000 pounds shall be parked, stored or allowed to remain for more than two hours on any lot or parcel of land in front of the setback line, or on the street, in any residential district.

However, this section shall not apply to such vehicles used for conveying the necessary tools and materials to premises where labor using such tools and materials is to be performed during the actual time of parking of such vehicles, nor to the actual time during which such vehicles are being loaded or unloaded or used to deliver or hoist property or merchandise for completion of delivery as long as such activities referred to in this provision are conducted diligently and without unnecessary delay.

IS HEREBY AMENDED IN PARAGRAPH 1 TO READ:

No commercial tractor, truck, trailer or commercial automobile weighing more than 8,000 pounds shall be parked, stored, or allowed on any lot or parcel of land or on the street in any residential district.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
