

ORDINANCE NO. C-30-87

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE PLAT OF McDOWELL ROAD
AND EASEMENTS, TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. C-42-86
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Plat of Parkdale Drive and easements was accepted by Ordinance NO. C-42-86; and

WHEREAS, the Grove City Thoroughfare Plan names the proposed Parkdale Drive as McDowell Road; and

WHEREAS, the proposed McDowell Road will be five lanes with fifty-five feet of pavement; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that it is necessary to accept the new plat of McDowell Road and begin construction immediately;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. C-42-86, an ordinance to accept the Plat of Parkdale Drive and Easements, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The plat of McDowell Road and easements situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, Township of Jackson, City of Grove City and being in Virginia Military Survey NO. 8321, containing 1,770 acres more or less, out of the 92.634 acre tract of Record in Vol. 3802, Page 262 as conveyed to George Wimpey of Ohio, Inc., records of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio is hereby accepted.

SECTION 3. Easements, where indicated, are hereby accepted for public utility services, including but not limited to, water, sanitary sewers, electricity and telephone, and for storm water drainage systems for the construction, operation and maintenance of the facilities to provide such services and systems above and beneath the ground.

SECTION 4. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.




