

ORDINANCE NO. C-32-72

AN ORDINANCE SUPPORTING THE ACTION OF THE CENTRAL OHIO MAYORS' AND MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS' COUNCIL IN OBTAINING A UNIFORM GAS RATE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PAY GROVE CITY'S SHARE FOR LEGAL FEES AND AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT/FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PAY AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00 FOR SUCH EXPENSE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Grove City in Resolution No. CR-15-70, passed on December 17, 1970, requested a uniform gas rate within Franklin County, and

WHEREAS, since that time the Franklin County Mayors' Council, now known as the Central Ohio Mayors' and Municipal Officials' Council, has been meeting with the Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. in order to try to get a uniform gas rate for the Franklin County area, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to retain legal counsel for said effort, and

WHEREAS, the legal expenses for supporting this effort should be borne by the municipalities involved,

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Grove City wishes to go on record as continuing to express their support of the action of the Central Ohio Mayors' and Municipal Officials' Council in working to establish a uniform gas rate in Franklin County.

SECTION 2. The Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement to pay Grove City's share, based on present general fund budget, for legal fees to achieve this uniform rate for the Franklin County area when requested to do so by the Central Ohio Mayors' and Municipal Officials' Council in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00.

SECTION 3. The Administrative Assistant/Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Grove City's share for legal fees and expenses as set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance from the General Fund.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




