

ORDINANCE NO. C-33-76

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 935.03 OF THE GROVE CITY
CODE OF ORDINANCES REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF SEWER TAPPERS
AND CONTRACTORS

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the protection of the citizens of the city that sewer tappers and contractors be knowledgeable of their work; and

WHEREAS, the license fee paid by such sewer tappers and contractors should be increased to be in conformity with other license fees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 935.03 of the Code of Ordinances which reads:

No person shall engage in or work at the trade or occupation of sewer construction or tapping in the City either as a sewer tapper or sewer contractor unless that person is a holder of a license then in force issued by the City giving that person the right to perform or supervise such work or unless that person has then in his employ a holder of the license then in force supervising the work. The license shall be obtained by application therefor to the Mayor and/or Director of Finance and application shall be accompanied by a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00).

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

No person shall engage in or work at the trade or occupation of sewer construction or tapping in the City either as a sewer tapper or sewer contractor unless that person is a holder of a license then in force issued by the City giving that person the right to perform or supervise such work or unless that person has then in his employ a holder of the license then in force supervising the work. The license shall be obtained by application to the Mayor. Application shall be accompanied by proof of applicant holding a sewer tapping license in force at the time of application from the City of Columbus, Ohio or Franklin County Department of Sanitation and shall be accompanied by a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


