

# ORDINANCE C-35-08

## AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE ROAD IMPROVEMENT FUND AND REAPPROPRIATE THESE FUNDS

WHEREAS, Ordinances C-02, 03, 04 and 05-08 appropriated monies to be used for respective projects but did not designate the fund into which the appropriated monies would be transferred and spent from; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to transfer the funds to the accounts from which they will be spent and re-appropriate the monies to enable their expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. There is hereby transferred \$18,121.01 from the General Fund into the Road Improvement Fund and re-appropriated into acct. #305-3051-8600-780 for the Current Expense of overhead utility lines that cross over Old Stringtown Road.

SECTION 2. There is hereby transferred \$45,000.00 from the General Fund into the Road Improvement Fund and re-appropriated into acct. #305-3052-5500-780 for the Current Expense of maintaining compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II requirements.

SECTION 3. There is hereby transferred \$1,450,000.00 from the General Fund into the Road Improvement Fund and re-appropriated into acct. #305-3012-8600-780 for the Current Expense of the 2008 Street Program.


SECTION 4. There is hereby transferred \$150,500.00 from the General Fund into the Road Improvement Fund and re-appropriated into acct. #305-3032-8600-780 for the Current Expense of soil removal.






