

ORDINANCE C-37-10

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$34,497.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF ENGINEERING THE GREEN FRAME/TOWN CENTER IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, under CR-11-10, the City Administrator was charged to encourage alternative development on the Lumberyard Project site, and stimulate strategic investment into the City's urban core; and

WHEREAS, under CR-12-10, Council requested the Administration to submit a suggested priority list for community improvements outlined in the Green Frame Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Administration's goal is to define the City's reinvestment in the Town Center infrastructure and support redevelopment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, in order to better define the impacts of the proposed Green Frame roadway improvements to existing utilities, properties and business operations, and to better define constructability and project cost, it is necessary for the City Administration to refine the Green Frame planning recommendations to support the Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, this proposed Preliminary Engineering will support future funding opportunities with a definable improvements and scope.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$34,497.00 from the unappropriated monies of the General Fund to account number 001-0012-7900-413 for the Current Expense of Engineering for the Green Frame/Town Center Improvements.

SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for Current Expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.


