

ORDINANCE NO. C-41-82  
(as amended)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 351 OF THE GROVE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ENACT NEW SECTION 351.17 ENTITLED "PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS"

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WHEREAS, the City has received numerous complaints concerning the parking of commercial vehicles in residential districts; and

WHEREAS, the residents of these areas should be protected from such nuisances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT


SECTION 1. Chapter 351 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to include Section 351.17 entitled "Parking of Commercial Vehicles in Residential Districts" which shall read:

"No commercial tractor, truck, trailer or commercial automobile weighing more than eight thousand (8000) pounds shall be parked, stored or allowed to remain for more than two (2) hours on any lot or parcel of land in front of the set-back line, or on the street, in any residential district.

Provided, however, that this section shall not apply to such vehicles used for conveying the necessary tools and materials to premises where labor using such tools and materials is to be performed during the actual time of parking of such vehicles nor to the actual time during which such vehicles are being loaded or unloaded or used to deliver or hoist property or merchandise for completion of delivery as long as such activities referred to in this provision are conducted diligently and without unnecessary delay."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
