AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$1,077,000.00 FROM THE COUNTY \$5 LICENSE FUND FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE OF SOUTHWEST BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS


WHEREAS, Franklin County Commissioner Resolution No. 0458-13 allocated and encumbered funds of \$1,077,000.00 from the County Motor Vehicle License Tax for Southwest Boulevard Improvements; and

WHEREAS, appropriation of these funds is necessary to improve Southwest Boulevard at the Demorest Road and WalMart/Beulah Park Entranceway intersections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$1,077,000.00 from the unappropriated monies of the County \$5 License Fund to account number 106000.578000 for the Current Expense of Southwest Boulevard Improvements.

SECTION 2. This ordinance appropriates for current expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect.
