

ORDINANCE NO. C-47-77

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND
AND OTHER EXPENSES FOR WHICH THE CITY OF GROVE CITY MUST PRO-
VIDE DURING THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1977

WHEREAS, the Administrative Assistant has been performing the duties of Director of Public Service for the City of Grove City since January 1, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the 1977 appropriations Ordinance No. C-100-76 did not include any appropriations for the Director of Public Service's Department, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed a Director of Public Service for the City; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make appropriations for the twelve months ending December 31, 1977 for each of the several objects for which the city must provide out of the monies known to be in the treasury, or to come into the treasury, from the collection of all taxes and from all other sources of revenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. From the monies known as the Street Fund and all monies estimated to come into said fund from any and all sources during the twelve month period ending December 31, 1977, there hereby is appropriated for the use of the several departments, offices and objects for which the city must provide the following sums for the use during the twelve month period ending December 31, 1977.

SECTION 2. From the monies known as the Sewer Fund and all monies estimated to come into said fund from any and all sources during the twelve month period ending December 31, 1977, there hereby is appropriated for the use of the several departments, offices and objects for which the city must provide the following sums for the use during the twelve month period ending December 31, 1977.

SECTION 3. From the monies known as the Water Fund and all monies estimated to come into said fund from any and all sources during the twelve month period ending December 31, 1977, there hereby is appropriated for the use of the several departments, offices and objects for which the city must provide the following sums for the use during the twelve month period ending December 31, 1977.

SECTION 4. That from any monies which shall be expended for the above appropriations and which are a proper charge against any other department, or against any person, firm, or corporation shall, if repaid within the period covered by such appropriations, be credited to the fund from which such payment was made and be considered as reappropriated from such original purposes; provided that the net total expenditures under any item of said appropriation shall not exceed the amount of said item.



The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to issue his check against the appropriate city account for the amount appropriated and for the purpose stated in this ordinance upon receiving the proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by an officer authorized by law to approve same or authorized by an ordinance or resolution of council to make expenditures.

SECTION 6. This ordinance provides for appropriations for current expenses and it shall therefore to into immediate effect.


