

ORDINANCE NO. C-49-79
(as amended)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1101.05(m) OF THE GROVE CITY CODE
OR ORDINANCES THAT STATES REQUIREMENTS FOR STREET LIGHTS

WHEREAS, the street light standard has been changed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY,
STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 1101.05(m) of the Grove City Code of Ordinances which reads:

Lighting shall be provided on public streets by means of lighting assemblies consisting of a minimum 8,000 lumen, mercury vapor light on aluminum pole. This lighting assembly shall be no less than twenty-four feet about the ground's surface at the pole base. These assemblies and the underground cables shall be located three feet in back of the curb street and three feet beyond the edge of the paved shoulder for uncurbed streets. The assembly shall be installed not less than 200 feet and not more than 300 feet apart. One assembly shall be located within 200 feet of the end of each cul-de-sac. One assembly shall be located at each street intersection. Blocks shorter than 400 feet shall not require an intermediate pole.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

Lighting shall be provided on public streets by means of lighting assemblies using a 100 watt, 120 volt high pressure luminaire, or equivalent lighting assemblies approved by the Director of Public Service, on aluminum poles. These lighting assemblies shall be no less than twenty-four feet above the ground's surface at the pole base. These assemblies and the underground cables shall be located three feet in back of the street curb and beyond the edge of the paved shoulder for uncurbed streets. The assembly shall be installed not less than 250 feet and not more than 350 feet apart. One assembly shall be located within 200 feet on the end of each cul-de-sac. One assembly shall be located at each street intersection. Blocks shorter than 500 feet apart shall not require an intermediate lighting assembly.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




