AN ORDINANCE NO. C-5-59

To provide compensation for the Director of Law

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Mayor it is necessary to immediately establish compensation for the Director of Law, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the daily operation of the Department of Law, and that the services of a Director of Law are immediately necessary for the preservation of public health, peace, property, and safety, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the daily operation of the City of Grove City with respect to the transition from Village to City status and the establishment of proper ordinances under the charter of the City of Grove City; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City:

Sec. 1. That pursuant to ordinance No. C-5-59, it is hereby determined that it is immediately necessary to provide for compensation for the Director of Law.

Sec. 2. That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to appoint a Director of Law.

~~Sec. 3. That the Mayor or such person to whom he delegates such authority be and hereby is authorized and directed to cause the preparation of the necessary payrolls and vouchers to compensate said Director of Law at the following annual rate:~~

Hourly rate of \$15⁰⁰ per hour*
~~Sec. 4. That the Mayor or such person to whom he delegates such authority be and hereby is authorized and directed to cause the preparation of the necessary payrolls and vouchers to compensate the said Director of Law for the purpose of recording the ordinances of the City of Grove City at the hourly rate of ~~\$15.00~~, which compensation shall be in addition to the annual rate described in Section 3 above.~~

Sec. 5. That upon presentation of the payrolls and vouchers properly executed in accordance with the Charter of said City, the Director of Law is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer in the payment of wages above determined.

IN THE VILLAGE OF GROVE CITY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 5-59

Declaring the necessity and intention of appropriating land on Hoover Road for the expansion of Grove City Sewage Treatment Plant and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of March, 1959, the Council of the village of Grove City, Ohio, adopted Resolution No. A-5-59, declaring the necessity and intention of appropriating the land hereinafter described, notice of the adoption of which resolution has been served on the owners, persons in possession and having an interest of record in said premises; and now therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the village of Grove City, Ohio, two thirds of all the members elected, thereto concurring.

Section 1. That the fee simple interest in and to the following described real estate be and the same is hereby appropriated for the public purpose of expanding and improving the Grove City Sewage Treatment Plant:

Situate in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin and in the Township of Jackson and being part of Survey No. 8231, Virginia Military Lands and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Hoover Road, same point being the southwesterly corner of that certain 1.60 Acre Tract conveyed to the Village of Grove City and shown of record in Deed Book 1045, page 320, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, same point also being N. 5° 00' E., a distance of 263.70 ft. from the southwesterly corner of a certain 20.0 Acre Tract of which the above mentioned 1.60 Acre Tract was a part; thence from said point of beginning S. 85° 00' E., and along the southerly line of the above mentioned 1.60 Acre Tract, a distance of 308.0 ft. to a stake; thence N. 5° 00' E., and along the easterly line of the aforementioned 1.60 Acre Tract conveyed to the Village of Grove City and passing the northeasterly corner of said 1.60 Acre Tract, at 266.10 ft., a distance of 316.10 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 76° 21' E., a distance of 200.48 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 5° 00' W. and parallel to the easterly line of the above mentioned 1.60 Acre Tract and 190.0 ft. therefrom, as measured at right angles a distance of 470.00 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 85° 00' W. and parallel to the southerly line of the above mentioned 1.60 Acre Tract and the southerly line of same extended easterly and 90.0 ft. southerly therefrom as measured at right angles, a distance of 498.0 ft. to a point in the center line of Hoover Road, same point being N. 5° 00' E., a distance of 173.70 ft. from the southwesterly corner of a certain 20.0 Acre Tract; thence N. 5° 00' E., a distance of 90.0 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 2.547 Acres; subject to all easements and restrictions shown of record; also subject to right-of-way for Hoover Road.

Section 2. That the solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to apply to a court of competent jurisdiction to have a jury empaneled to make inquiry into and assess the compensation to be paid for the fee simple interest in the said property.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the village of Grove City, in said expansion and improvement of said sanitary sewer plant, particularly the elimination of present pollution of the stream into which said plant empties, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
