

ORDINANCE NO. C-5-83

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT THE GROVE CITY DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY,
IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GANTZ FARM HOUSE RESTORATION COMMITTEE,
TO HOLD A WINE FESTIVAL AT THE GANTZ ROAD PARK ON MAY 7, 1983

WHEREAS, the Grove City Department of History, in conjunction with the Gantz Farm House Restoration Committee, wishes to hold a wine festival at the Gantz Road Park on May 7, 1983 for the purpose of raising money for the restoration of the Gantz Farm House; and

WHEREAS, Section 903.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City states: "No drugs or alcoholic beverages shall be permitted on park property";


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Permission is hereby granted to the Grove City Department of History to hold a wine festival at the Gantz Road Park on May 7, 1983.

SECTION 2. The provision of Section 903.01(b) of the Codified Ordinances that no alcoholic beverages be permitted on park property is hereby waived for this one occasion of a wine festival on May 7 at the Gantz Road Park.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
