

ORDINANCE NO. C-54-78

AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT SECTION 525.091 OF THE GROVE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO FLEEING A POLICE OFFICER AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city that fleeing a police officer, whether on foot or in a vehicle, be made a crime; and

WHEREAS, there is no provision at the present time in the Grove City Code of Ordinances with respect to fleeing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT


SECTION 1. Section 525.091 entitled "Fleeing" is hereby enacted and shall read:


- (a) No person shall wilfully elude or flee a police officer after receiving a visible or audible signal from the police office to stop.
- (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of fleeing a police officer, a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.


