

ORDINANCE C-59-65

An Ordinance to make appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures for the City of Grove City, State of Ohio during the year 1966.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio

Section 13. And the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore approved by the Board of Officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriation herein made.

Section 14. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
