

ORDINANCE C-64-66

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 93, ENTITLED
"FIRE REGULATIONS" TO INCLUDE SECTION 93.27,
Entitled "FIRE EXTINGUISHERS, APPROVAL REQUIRED",
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide regulations for the sale and/or installation of adequate and reliable fire extinguishers within the city limits of the City of Grove City; and

WHEREAS, said regulations immediately affect the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Grove City and an emergency exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that


SECTION 1. Section 93.27, entitled "Fire Extinguishers, approval required", of Chapter 93, entitled "Fire Regulations", is enacted to read:

No person, directly or through an agent shall sell or offer for sale in the City, any make, type or model of extinguisher, either new or used, unless such make, type or model of extinguisher has first been tested and is approved and labeled by the Factory Mutual Laboratories, Underwriters' Laboratories, Inc., or other testing laboratory approved by the Director of Public Safety as providing adequate and reliable tests and examination; and it shall be unlawful for any person, directly or through an agent, to deliver or make available for the use in the City, any make, type or model of extinguisher which is not first tested and/or serviced as required in the standards of the national Fire Protection Association entitled "Standard for the Installation, Maintenance and Use of Portable Fire Extinguishers" (NFPA No. 10), dated June 1959, as amended, which regulations hereby are adopted and made by reference a part of this Code.

No person, directly or through an agent, shall sell or offer for sale in the City, any make, type or model of liquid fire extinguisher producing toxic vapors, whether laboratory approved or not, except for use on a motor vehicle or a motor carrier as authorized by the law of this State and laws of the United States relating to motor carriers or where otherwise permitted by the Fire Prevention Bureau.

SECTION 2. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto and made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
