

ORDINANCE NO. C-64-87

AN ORDINANCE TO DEDICATE THE PARK ON COLUMBUS STREET
AS "SWEARINGEN PARK"
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, James Swearingen has been the Band Director of the Grove City High School since 1973; and

WHEREAS, during those years he has been a tremendous force and inspiration for hundreds of students; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that the city should honor James Swearingen for the time, effort and dedication to the youth of this City; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the daily operation of the city that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens in that there is not an official name for the park on Columbus Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. This Council hereby declares the park on the south side of Columbus Street near Knapp Drive shall henceforth from the date of August 12, 1987 be known as "SWEARINGEN PARK", said park dedicated to the award winning Grove City High School Bands under his direction from 1973 to 1987.

SECTION 2. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.


