

ORDINANCE NO. C-65-85

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION  
OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS  
COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF  
GROVE CITY, OHIO

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Grove City, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the editing, arrangement and numbering of those ordinances enacted by Council from April 1, 1983 to May 6, 1985, as listed in the Comparative Section Table, are hereby approved and adopted as printed in the 1985 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances so as to achieve uniformity of style and classification. A copy of such Replacement Pages are attached to this ordinance and incorporated as a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That the following sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes, as amended, are hereby approved and adopted as amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly:

Traffic Code

- 313.03 Regulates turns on red traffic control signals.
- 313.05 Pedestrian control signals may reflect symbols of a walking person and upraised palm.
- 331.35 Occupying a moving manufactured home prohibited.
- 331.38 Prima-facie violation of failure to stop for school bus.
- 335.09(a) Vehicle license required display including validation and County ID stickers.
- 339.03 Vehicle maximum width, height and length.
- 374.11 Moped license required.
- 374.12 Mutilation of serial numbers, stickers or plates.

General Offenses Code


- 501.01 Owner, property and services redefined to include cable tv theft and computer crimes.
- 501.09 Exempts hazardous waste law from municipal attempts coverage since State law provides felony coverage.
- 525.02 Falsification prohibited.
- 529.01 Intoxicating liquor redefined to include 6% by volume.
- 529.02 Sales to minors; prohibitions and misrepresentations.
- 529.04 Liquor consumption or open container in motor vehicle.
- 529.06 Posting liquor age warning signs.
- 529.07 Open container prohibited.
- 529.09 Hours of sale or consumption.
- 533.14 Child pornography related crimes.
- 537.07 Child endangering prohibited.
- 537.10 Telephone harassment prohibited.
- 537.14 Domestic violence prohibited.
- 537.15 Violation of temporary protection order.
- 537.16 Illegally furnishing cigarettes or tobacco to minors.
- 537.17 Criminal child enticement.
- 541.03 Criminal damaging or endangering of property.
- 541.04 Criminal mischief prohibited.
- 545.01 Owner, property and services redefined to include cable tv theft and computer crimes.
- 545.03 Subject property considered a felony offense.
- 545.05 Petty theft prohibited.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


