

ORDINANCE NO. C-65-86

AN ORDINANCE TO DEDICATE THE PARK ON ARBUTUS AVENUE AS THE
"CREAD LAWLESS NEIGHBORHOOD PARK" AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Marshal "Cread" Lawless has been a life-long resident of
Grove City; and

WHEREAS, Cread Lawless has been active in the community in various
capacities such as a volunteer with the Jackson Township Fire Department,
an employee of Beulah Park and the 3M Company and now a columnist with the
Southwest Messenger allowing the populus an insight to an earlier time with
his column "Our Pictorial Past"; and

WHEREAS, Cread and his wife Ruth have for many years been parkside
residents on Arbutus Avenue; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the daily operation of the city that
affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grove City in that
there is not an official name for the park on Arbutus Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY,
STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. This Council hereby declares the park separating Arbutus
Avenue south from Kingston Avenue to Bruce Avenue shall henceforth from this
date be known as the "CREAD LAWLESS NEIGHBORHOOD PARK".

SECTION 2. For reasons stated in the preamble and made a part hereof,
this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect
and be in force from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor.




