

ORDINANCE NO. C-67-88
(as amended)

AN ORDINANCE TO REINCORPORATE SECTION 529.07
INTO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GROVE
CITY RELATING TO POSSESSION OF OPEN CONTAINER
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. C-101-87 accepted the updated and replacement pages for the Codified Ordinances of Grove City; and

WHEREAS, Section 529.07 of the Codified Ordinances entitled "Open Container Prohibited" was inadvertently removed from the code; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the daily operation of the Police Department that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City that this law must be in the Codified Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 529.07 OPEN CONTAINER PROHIBITED is hereby reincorporated into the Codified Ordinances of Grove City and shall read:

(a) No person shall have in his possession an opened container of beer or intoxicating liquor in a State liquor store, or on the premises of the holder of any permit issued by the Department of Liquor Control, or in any other public place. This section does not apply to beer or intoxicating liquor which has been lawfully purchased for consumption on the premises where bought of a holder of an A-A, A-2, D-1, D-2, D-3, D-3a, D-4, D-4a, D-5, D-5a, D-5b, D-5c, D-7, E, F, and F2 permit. This section does not apply to beer or intoxicating liquor consumed on the premises of a convention facility as provided in Ohio R.C. 4303.201. (ORC 4301.62)

(b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.


