

ORDINANCE NO. C-68-75

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 903.01 (a) OF THE CODE  
OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO LIGHTED TENNIS COURTS  
AT WINDSOR PARK

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1975 the City Council of the City of Grove City approved Ordinance No. C-34-75, an ordinance to appropriate monies to install lights at the tennis courts at Windsor Park, and

WHEREAS, the Council deemed it necessary to provide lighted courts for the citizens of Grove City, and

WHEREAS, the specifications have been met and the lights are in operation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 903.01(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Grove City which reads:


Parks shall be for the use of the general public during daylight hours unless otherwise specified by the Park Board.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

Parks shall be for the use of the general public during daylight hours unless otherwise specified by the Park Board except for the lighted tennis courts at Windsor Park which shall remain open for use until 11:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
