

ORDINANCE C-69-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS OF PART NINE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF GROVE CITY, OHIO TITLED STREETS, UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES

WHEREAS; the City of Grove City has reviewed the projected revenues, operations and expenses of our Water and Sanitary Sewer funds, and

WHEREAS, the City has found that the increasing operation and capital costs of the Sewer Department can be off set by the reallocation of revenues currently collected for the Water System Improvement bonds that were recently retired, and

WHEREAS, the City believes that the reallocation of the existing rates will provide the necessary financing to continue the quality of service with no increase to our residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 953.01 is hereby amended to read:

953.01 WATER RATES

The established water rate of charge for every thousand cubic feet of water used per month, or a period of time equaling a month, shall be as shown below:

SECTION 2. Section 939.12(a) is hereby amended to read:

939.12 SEWER SERVICE CHARGES, BILLING, LIABILITY


(a) The following rates are established for the sewer service charges to be charged all users of the City's sewerage systems:



	<u>North</u>	<u>South</u>
Sewer service charge per 1,000 cubic feet of sewage equal to or of less concentration than standard strength sewage	\$3.00 <u>3.55</u>	\$3.00 <u>3.55</u>
Minimum sewer service charge per month per connection	\$2.00	\$2.00

The volume of sewage discharged into the sewerage system shall be taken as being the same as the volume of water use recorded in the water meter for the building, house, structure or property receiving sewer service, except when a deduct meter installation is approved by the Director of Public Service or it is determined that the sewerage system is receiving more volume that is recorded by the water meter.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.


