

ORDINANCE NO. C-69-82

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1301.99 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES ENTITLED "PENALTY" UNDER THE BUILDING CODE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, an emergency exists that affects the health, safety and welfare of the citizens in that Ordinance No. C-63-82 has been enacted to control political signs and a penalty must be mandated for violations of Ordinance C-63-82;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 1301.99 of the city's Codified Ordinances which reads:


Any person, firm or corporation which violates or fails to comply with any provision of this Part Thirteen-Building Code for which no other penalty has been provided, or fails to comply with any order or regulation made thereunder, or builds in violation of a building permit or certificate issued thereunder shall be fined not more than one hundred (\$100.00) for each and every violation and noncompliance; a separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which an offense occurs or continues. The imposition of a penalty shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue and the application of such penalty shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:


Any person, firm or corporation which violates or fails to comply with any provision of this Part Thirteen-Building Code for which no other penalty has been provided, or fails to comply with any order or regulation made thereunder, or builds in violation of a building permit or certificate issued thereunder shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree for each and every violation and noncompliance. A separate offense shall be deemed committed


