

ORDINANCE NO. C-81-86

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 351.03 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ENACT SUBPARAGRAPH (s) TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF VEHICLES WITHIN FIVE FEET OF A RESIDENTIAL MAIL BOX

WHEREAS, there have been numerous complaints about motor vehicles parking near and in front of residential mail boxes at the curb; and

WHEREAS, the United State Postal Service will not deliver mail to said mail boxes that are obstructed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Subsection 351.03(s) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Grove City is hereby enacted and shall read:

- (s) Within five feet of a residential detached mailbox between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday except holidays when mail is not delivered.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.




