

ORDINANCE NO. C-83-76

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 725.01 (b) OF THE GROVE CITY
CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCREASE THE LIMITS OF LIABILITY
INSURANCE THAT WASTE COLLECTORS MUST SECURE ON MOTOR VEHICLES

(as amended)

WHEREAS, the limits of liability insurance for vehicles belonging to
waste collectors are not high enough and are outdated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY,
STATE OF OHIO, THAT

SECTION 1. Section 725.01 (b) of the Grove City Code of Ordinances which
reads:

(b) Liability Insurance

The licensee shall secure, at his own cost and maintain at all times during
the effective term of the license, liability insurance on all motor vehicles
and equipment used within the corporate limits of the City. Such insurance
shall cover property damage, personal injury and death arising from per-
formance of the service covered by the license issued. The amount of re-
quired insurance shall not be less than the following:

- (1) \$10,000 for property damage for each accident;
- (2) \$50,000 for bodily injury for each person;
- (3) \$100,000 for bodily injury for two or more persons.

The licensee shall submit evidence to the Director that such insurance is in
force before a license will be issued.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

(b) Liability Insurance

The licensee shall secure, at his own cost and maintain at all times during
the effective term of the license, liability insurance on all motor vehicles
and equipment used within the corporate limits of the City. Such insurance
shall cover property damage, personal injury and death arising from per-
formance of the service covered by the license issued. The amount of re-
quired insurance shall not be less than the following:

- (1) \$ 50,000 for property damage for each accident;
- (2) \$100,000 for bodily injury for each person;
- (3) \$300,000 for bodily injury for two or more persons.


The licensee shall submit evidence to the Director that such insurance is in
force before a license will be issued.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1977.




