

ORDINANCE

C-84-60

An Ordinance to Establish Rates for
Plumbing Licenses and To Amend Ordinance
281 and To Declare an Emergency

12-19-60

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the Building Department with respect to issuance of Plumbing Licenses and such issue directly affects the health and safety of the Citizens of Grove City, Ohio and should be immediately regulated.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Grove City, State of Ohio, that

1181.02 SECTION 1. Any person may make application for registration to do plumbing, sewer laying, drain laying and sewage disposal installation work within the City of Grove City, Ohio, who has a master plumber's license in force issued to him by any municipality in Ohio having a plumbers' examining and licensing board requiring a written and practical examination for the issuance of such license. Any person may make application to the Mayor and/or the Finance Director for registration to do sewer laying, drain laying and sewage disposal installation work only, within the City of Grove City who has a license in force to engage in the business of sewer or drain laying issued to him by any municipality in Ohio having an examining board requiring a written and practical examination for the issuance of such license. A fee of \$15.00 will accompany the application for registration of the master plumber and a fee of \$10.00 will accompany the application of the licensed sewer or drain layer. If a master plumber or a sewer or drain layer has his license revoked by the municipality issuing the same it shall automatically revoke his registration to do plumbing, sewer laying, drain laying or sewage disposal installation work with the limits of the City of Grove City.

SECTION 2. Section 23 and Section 24 of Ordinance 281 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the treasury for payment from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certification and voucher therefor approved by the Board or officers authorized by law to approve the same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law and ordinance.

SECTION 3. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and approval by the Council of the City of Grove City.
