

## RESOLUTION NO. CR-41-92

### A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT A PROGRAM OF WASTE REDUCTION, RECYCLING AND RECYCLED PRODUCT PROCUREMENT FOR CITY OFFICES

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Solid Waste District is proposing a forty percent (40%) waste reduction goal by 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County landfill is estimated to have less than five (5) years remaining disposal life; and

WHEREAS, over fifty percent (50%) of the materials found in the City's municipal solid waste stream could be recycled; and

WHEREAS, various City departments are currently independently involved in recycling and waste minimization practices, and purchasing products with recycled content material; and

WHEREAS, it is important for City departments to work in concert to reduce the amount of waste generated and to recycle as much of the remaining waste as possible; and

WHEREAS, the City MUST cooperatively intensify its effort to stimulate the markets for recycled materials by closing the recycling loop through procurement of products that contain recycled content material.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Recycling Coordinator will develop and implement programs for all City departments that focus on waste reduction and recycling of all materials used.

SECTION 2. The City Recycling Coordinator and Finance Department shall research and coordinate the distribution of information regarding products with recycled content material and sources of supply.

SECTION 3. All City Departments will purchase, when feasible, paper supplies that are both recycled and recyclable, and made from post consumer recycled content paper.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
