**A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING AND ENDORSING
THE TOWN CENTER MURAL PROJECT LOCATED ON THE
SHEDROW SALOON IN THE HISTORICAL PRESERVATION AREA**

WHEREAS, it is desirable to compliment the Town Center by painting a Mural on the side of The Shedrow Saloon; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been reached with the owners of The Shedrow Saloon; and

WHEREAS, two local artists have been commissioned to design this Mural; and

WHEREAS, an amount, not to exceed, \$19,450.00 has been determined; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to have community involvement through donations to this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby acknowledges and endorses the Town Center Mural project.





GROVE CITY MURAL AGREEMENT

CR-80-00

This agreement between the City of Grove City (City) and Earl Nicholson and David Maple (Artists) whereby the Artists shall create a 12 x 32 mural depicting a scene of Park and Broadway circa 1924. The mural is to be painted on twelve (12) 4 x 8 MDO boards. The mural shall be fixed to the north wall of 3998 Broadway (aka Shedrow Saloon). The Artists shall purchase supplies and provide labor for the mural to include:

Material Costs

(12) 4 x 8 MDO Boards – good one side 5/8 – 3/4 inch thick \$.45 each	\$ 540.00
U-Channel – white & silicone – for edges of MDO - \$5 per ft. x 300	1,500.00
Primer – XIM Exterior Primer – wood	
2 coats – rollers – large brushes	90.00
Paints – Exterior acrylic latex – per gallon \$20 each	
10 gallons – prime colors and base colors	200.00
Liquitex – exterior varnish (matte or satin finish)	
Non-yellowing – 2 gallon \$60 each	120.00
Paint bare block, pre-seal and finish	1,000.00
Install and hardware by City under supervision of Artists	N/C
Cost of artwork for mural	
Comprehensive (optional) - Free (Gift to the City)	
Mural	\$16,000.00
Total	\$19,450.00

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The City shall affix the mural to the north wall under the direction and supervision of the Artists. The mural shall become the property of the City of Grove City at the time the (12) 4 x 8 MDO boards are purchased. Payment for the mural shall be in the following manner:

December 1, 2000	supplies and materials (up to) (upon presentation of invoices)	\$ <u>3,450.00</u>
February 1, 2001	20% of \$16,000.00	\$ <u>3,200.00</u>
April 1, 2001	20%	\$ <u>3,200.00</u>
June 1, 2001	20%	\$ <u>3,200.00</u>
August 1, 2001	20%	\$ <u>3,200.00</u>
September	Final Balance	\$ <u>3,200.00</u>

All rights to the artwork shall remain vested with the City. Reproduction rights remain with the Artists. Artists agree to license to the City, upon City's request, for the use of the image at a future date as the City determines. The license would be used for specific purposes and consideration would be determined by using a reasonable and fair cost. Final approval of this Agreement subject to approval of City Council and approval of a Memorandum of Understanding with the owners of 3998 Broadway.

The Artists agree to make the best effort to complete the mural by September 15, 2001.
