

RESOLUTION CR-10-11

A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 133.05 OF
THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES FOR THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Section 25.6 of the current Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge #9 Contract provides that a retiring Police Officer in good standing "shall be allowed to purchase his or her duty weapon from the City for a payment of \$1.00"; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the FOP Contract are not applicable to the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, Chief G. Joseph Wise has announced his retirement from the City of Grove City effective March 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Chief has served, in good standing, as a full-time officer in the City since 1984; and

WHEREAS, the City would like allow the Chief to purchase his duty weapon upon the same terms and conditions as the officers under the FOP Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROVE CITY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The provisions of Section 133.05 of the Codified Ordinances are hereby waived to allow Chief G. Joseph Wise, upon his retirement, to purchase his duty weapon for \$1.00.


SECTION 2. The resolution shall take effect at the earliest opportunity afforded by law.


