

A RESOLUTION TO INITIATE AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3.01 OF THE CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, Section 3.01 of the City Charter provides that at each regular municipal election a mayor shall be elected to serve a term of four years; and

WHEREAS, Section 7.01 of the City Charter provides that regular municipal elections shall be held in the odd numbered years; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.04 of the City Charter vests the power in council to initiate amendments to the Charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the City of Grove City, Ohio, that,

Section 1. Amendment of Section 3.01 of the City Charter be initiated to read as follows:

"At each alternating regular municipal election a mayor shall be elected to serve a term of four years."

Section 2. The clerk of council is hereby directed to certify this resolution to the city clerk.

Section 3. The city clerk is hereby directed to certify the question to be resolved to the Franklin County Board of Elections according to law in sufficient time as to have the issue decided at the regular municipal election next ensuing.

Section 4. The city clerk is hereby authorized and directed to perform all other duties as are required by law to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.
