

RESOLUTION NO. CR-2-70

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE PUBLIC UTILITIES
COMMISSION TO GRANT PERMANENT AUTHORITY
FOR THE OPERATION OF A BUS LINE TO GROVE CITY.

WHEREAS, there will be a hearing before the Public Utilities Commission on February 24, 1970, regarding the awarding of a permanent authority for the operation of a bus service between Grove City and Columbus; and

WHEREAS, a careful study has been made of the proposed services of both the Columbus Transit Company and the Lincoln Village Transit Company and their ability to provide such service; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of Council that the proposal of the Lincoln Village Transit Company provides better service and that said company has the means and ability to provide such service ;and


WHEREAS, the Lincoln Village Transit Company has provided good service to the citizens of Grove City under the temporary certificate awarded them by the Public Utilities Commission.


